BRAGA” INSTITUTE**

Article 1

CALL FOR APPLICATION

Call for applications for the award of scholarships academic year 2026/2027 for students enrolled at the University of Teramo and the "G. Braga" Institute, who possess the requirements set out in this call.

This call has been approved considering the following legislation:

The initial allocation provided, which will be subsequently integrated with further resources not yet quantifiable, is €1,837,406.62, of which 30% is reserved for the first year of all degree courses of the University of Teramo and the ordinary and/or experimental 1st and 2nd level courses (new system), including the two-year qualifying program for teacher training A31-32-77 (so-called Bi-For-Doc D.M. 137/07) of the "G. Braga" Institute.

Benefits are granted only once each year and/or course level.

RANKINGS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE FIRST YEAR OF DEGREE COURSES, SO-CALLED "FILTER SEMESTER", SPECIALIZATION SCHOOLS, AND PHD RESEARCH PROGRAMS.

The benefits are allocated on the basis of a single ranking, ordered in ascending order based on the I.S.E.E. value. In case of equal values, precedence in the ranking will be determined by the I.S.P.E. value, and, in case of further equality, by chronological age (the younger candidate takes precedence).

Students enrolling in the so-called "filter semester" pursuant to D.M. MUR no. 447 of 11/07/2025 at the University of Teramo must submit the scholarship application and all required supporting documentation within the deadlines indicated in this competition announcement.

These students will be suspended in the ranking until their final enrollment in the second semester, as per Art. 3 of D.M. no. 447/2025. Furthermore, these students will benefit from the canteen service, provided that in-person teaching activities are scheduled for at least 51%. Students who, after completing the so-called "filter semester" at other Universities, enroll for the second semester in the same course or an akin course at the University of Teramo, must submit their scholarship application within the deadlines that will be announced later, without prejudice to the provisions of this call regarding documentation supporting the application. The right of ADSU Teramo to regulate differently the cases of students attending the so-called "filter semester" in the event of any future approval of ministerial or regional provisions that differ from this call for applications remains unaffected.

RANKINGS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN DEGREE COURSES - YEARS FOLLOWING THE FIRST

The share of the allocation reserved for years following the first will be divided among the various Faculties, Degree courses, and course years of the University of Teramo and the "G. Braga" Institute in proportion to the number of eligible students in the rankings, allocating, in any case, at least one scholarship for each individual year. The benefits are allocated based on merit, calculated by multiplying the sum of the credits, including educational credits, by the sum of the grades obtained in the exams included in the study plan and taken by August 10, 2026. In case of equal merit, economic conditions are considered, taking into account the I.S.E.E. value, in case of equal I.S.E.E. also the I.S.P.E. value, and, if necessary, the chronological age (the younger candidate takes precedence).

RANKINGS FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN SPECIALIZATION SCHOOLS AND PHD RESEARCH PROGRAMS - YEARS FOLLOWING THE FIRST

The rankings are formulated based on the first enrollment related to the level of study and ordered in ascending order following the criteria established for first-year students.

Article 2 RECIPIENTS AND DURATION

Italian or foreign students, political refugees, and stateless persons who are enrolled for the a.y. 2026/2027 at the University of Teramo or the "G. Braga" Institute **no later than March 31, 2027**, can participate in the Competition.

Students who obtain their first-level bachelor's degree in an extraordinary session, with subsequent enrollment in a two-year master's degree course, must be enrolled in the first year no later than **May 10, 2027**.

Regarding the "G. Braga" Institute, they must already hold a high school diploma and be enrolled in the upper period of the Old System or in the first and second-level academic diploma of the New System, including the two-year qualifying program for teacher training A31-32-77 (so-called Bi-For-Doc D.M. 137/07), if activated.

Based on the duration of studies, benefits will be awarded as follows:

- 1st-level degree courses (three-year), 2nd-level degree courses (two-year), and single-cycle degree courses (five-year) for a period of time equal to the duration provided by the relative teaching regulations, plus one semester related to the first year beyond the regular duration;
- specialization schools and PhD research programs for a period of time equal to the duration provided by their respective academic regulations.

Students who, after completing the so-called "filter semester" in Teramo or at other Universities, enroll for the second semester in the same course or an akin course at the University of Teramo, must have finalized their enrollment within the deadlines set by university regulations, without having paid any late fees, under penalty of exclusion from this competition.

Article 3

METHODS AND DEADLINES FOR ONLINE APPLICATION SUBMISSION

The application to participate in the competition can be submitted exclusively electronically, from the company website www.adsuteramo.it, under the section "ACCESSO UTENTE - Borse di studio - Alloggi - Mensa - Borse lavoro" (USER ACCESS - Scholarships - Accommodation - Canteen - Job grants). It is essential: to possess a SPID (Public Digital Identity System) identity to register and submit the application, with the sole exception of foreign students.

It is also essential for all students, both Italian and foreign, to possess a Certified Email Address (PEC).

Students who are not resident in Italy and who lack the required documentation may communicate their certified email address (PEC) prior to the disbursement of the second scholarship installment, where due, and in any event within the deadlines and in accordance with the procedures to be specified by the Agency. Failure to do so shall result in the suspension of payments.

By the deadline, a valid identification document must be uploaded in the personal data section of the aforementioned portal.

The strict deadline for submitting applications, both for the scholarship and for the accommodation assignment call, is set **NO LATER THAN 12:00 PM ON SEPTEMBER 7, 2026, under penalty of exclusion.**

The electronic system certifies the date and time of completion of the application. Until the deadline of the call, the student can modify, correct, or integrate the application already submitted. Any changes must be made exclusively online through the dedicated web portal. Once the deadline has expired, the application can no longer be modified in any way and will be considered final.

Article 4

INCOME AND ASSET REQUIREMENTS - ISEE CERTIFICATION FOR UNIVERSITY BENEFITS

Pursuant to MUR Ministerial Decree no. 1320 of 17/12/2021 and the regional guidelines issued with Regional Council Resolution no. 397 of 29/06/2026, the economic conditions of students with income and/or assets in Italy, or with income and/or assets both in Italy and

abroad, **must be certified by the ISEE year 2026 valid for university benefits**, drafted in accordance with current legislation, and must fall within the following limits:

- ISEE income no higher than €24,335.11
- ISPEE asset no higher than €52,902.43.

The Single Substitute Declaration (DSU) to obtain the ISEE 2026 certification valid for university benefits must be requested no later than the application deadline of September 7, 2026, under penalty of exclusion. Any amount received in the calendar year 2024 as a scholarship granted by regional bodies for the right to university education must be indicated in the DSU and will be deducted automatically.

UNREADABLE ISEE

In the event that a student is deemed "not eligible" in the first provisional ranking due to the company software failing to read the I.S.E.E. certification, despite having submitted the DSU within the aforementioned strict deadline, they must fill out an "online review request" (Art. 13) no later than 10 days after the publication of the first provisional ranking and simultaneously urge the issuing body to retransmit the certification online to I.N.P.S.

ISEE WITH ANNOTATIONS

Any ISEE for university benefits with "annotations" (meaning omissions or discrepancies) results in the suspension of the student's position in the ranking and the obligation to request a new DSU including the necessary additional information no later than the deadline for the review request, i.e., ten days from the publication of the provisional ranking referred to in Art. 13, under penalty of exclusion.

INDEPENDENT STUDENT ISEE

A student is considered independent and, therefore, constitutes a separate household on the condition that both of the following requirements are met: residence outside the housing unit of the family of origin, for at least two years prior to the date of submission of the DSU, in a home not owned by a member of the original family household; perception of income from employment or fiscally declared assimilated work, for at least two years, of no less than €9,000.00.

ISEE FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN PHD COURSES

Students enrolled in PhD courses can consider their family household according to ordinary rules or a restricted household composed exclusively of the applicant, their spouse, and children.

INVALID ISEE FOR UNIVERSITY BENEFITS

The submission of an ISEE certification not valid for university benefits leads to exclusion from the competition. Students who have nevertheless respected the deadlines for submitting the DSU may be readmitted to the ranking by submitting a review request to ADSU and a new DSU through a CAF to obtain the valid ISEE for university benefits, both within the strict deadline of 10 days set by the subsequent Art. 13.

ISEE FOR STUDENTS COMING FROM OTHER UNIVERSITIES ATTENDING THE SECOND SEMESTER

Students who, after completing the so-called "filter semester" at other Universities, enroll for the second semester in the same course or an akin course at the University of Teramo, must possess an ISEE 2026 certification valid for university benefits, readable and free of annotations, regardless of the DSU submission date, available by 31/12/2026 in the INPS database, under penalty of exclusion from the competition.

Article 5

INCOME AND ASSET REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

In order to obtain a Student Visa for University Enrollment (national type "D"), as per the MUR and Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation Circular valid for A.Y. 2026/27 and 2027/28, international students must meet the requirements set out in Art. 2 of the Circular itself. Therefore, the candidate students' positions will be suspended until official communication of enrollment in the chosen Course of Study is acquired from the Higher Education Institution (UNITE or Braga Musical Institute). For the evaluation of income and assets, international students with income and/or assets exclusively abroad are required to prove they meet the economic and family requirements of Art. 4 by transmitting, exclusively through the specific online procedure from their personal profile, the following

documentation no later than the strict deadline of October 7, 2026: the composition of the family household; the gross income received abroad in 2025 by each member of the family household; any buildings owned abroad by each member as of 12/31/2025, with their relative surface area specified, which will be conventionally valued at €500.00 per square meter; the movable assets available abroad as of 12/31/2025; any rent paid for the residence of the family household. The economic data are converted based on the average Euro exchange rate for the year 2025 determined by a provision of the Director of the Revenue Agency. In its absence, the provision of the Revenue Agency prot. 18293/2026 of 19/01/2026 relating to the average exchange rates of December 2025 will apply. This documentation must be issued by the competent Authorities of the country where the income was produced, where the buildings are owned, and where the assets are available, legalized by the competent Italian diplomatic authorities for the territory (Embassies) and with an Italian translation certified by the same authorities. The foreign authorities responsible for issuing documents required for the granting of scholarships to non-EU students are indicated in the MUR-MAECI Circular 2026/27. Alternatively, a certification from the diplomatic or consular representation in Italy of the country where the income was produced and assets are owned may be produced, written in Italian and legalized by the Prefectures pursuant to Art. 33, paragraph 4, of Presidential Decree no. 445 of December 28, 2000. The submission of documentation that does not exactly correspond to the specifications listed above will result in the non-acceptance of the application. Students enrolled in the first year of three-year or five-year courses, once enrollment is completed as certified by the competent Student Secretariats, must produce their income documentation no later than the strict deadline of September 7, 2026, in order to obtain the advance payment of the first installment by November 10, 2026, as provided for in Art. 14. It remains understood that the position of international students will be suspended in the ranking until the formal communication of the completion of enrollment/registration by the competent Student Secretariats, which must in any case occur within the strict deadlines indicated in Art. 2 of this Call. Students with income and/or assets exclusively abroad who, after completing the so-called "filter semester" at other Universities, enroll for the second semester in the same course or an akin course at the University of Teramo, must produce documentation proving their economic and family requirements within the same deadline that will be established for the submission of scholarship applications.

STUDENTS COMING FROM DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

Students coming from developing countries referred to in MUR Decree no. 176 of 24/02/2026 must present a certification from the Italian Representation in their country of origin or the Diplomatic Authority of their country in Italy certifying that the student does not belong to a family notoriously of high income and high social level.

STATELESS OR POLITICAL REFUGEE STUDENTS

This status must be proven by official documentation issued by the Civil Court for stateless students, and by the specific Commission established at the Ministry of the Interior for political refugees. These students are exempted from submitting declarations issued by Embassies and Consulates. For the evaluation of economic conditions, only income and assets possibly held in Italy are considered.

POLITICAL ASYLUM SEEKING STUDENTS

Political asylum-seeking students can apply for scholarships in the same manner as political refugees; however, the potential granting of the scholarship remains suspended until refugee status is officially recognized.

OTHER SPECIAL CASES

Pursuant to the explanatory note to the Circular issued by the Ministry of University and Research (MUR) and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation on July 3, 2026, the Agency reserves the right, in the exercise of its own discretion, to evaluate on a case-by-case basis the specific situations of students who are unable to submit the required documents within the prescribed deadlines because they come from territories affected by armed conflict or severe humanitarian crises. Such students, if excluded from or suspended in the provisional rankings, must, within the deadlines set out in the call for applications, submit a request for review if excluded, or, if suspended, submit a support ticket setting out the objective reasons that prevented timely submission of the documents, within the same deadline established for the request for review. The request for review, if excluded, or the ticket, if suspended, must indicate the following reason code: "extraordinary circumstances due to armed conflict or humanitarian crises.

Article 5 bis

ITALIAN STUDENTS WITH ASSETS AND INCOME EXCLUSIVELY ABROAD

For the evaluation of income and assets, Italian students with income and/or assets exclusively abroad are required to prove they meet the economic and family requirements of Art. 4 by transmitting, exclusively through the specific online procedure from their personal profile, the following documentation no later than the strict deadline of October 7, 2026: the composition of the family household; The gross income received abroad in 2025 by each member of the family household; any buildings owned abroad by each member as of 12/31/2025, with their relative surface area specified, which will be conventionally valued at €500.00 per square meter; the movable assets available abroad as of 12/31/2025; any rent paid for the residence of the family household. The economic data are converted based on the average Euro exchange rate for the year 2025 determined by a provision of the Director of the Revenue Agency. In its absence, the provision of the Revenue Agency prot.

18293/2026 of 19/01/2026 relating to the average exchange rates of December 2025 will apply. This documentation must be issued by the competent Authorities of the country where the income was produced, where the buildings are owned, and where the assets are available, legalized by the competent Italian diplomatic authorities for the territory (Embassies) and with an Italian translation certified by the same authorities.

Italian students with income and/or assets exclusively abroad who, after completing the so-called "filter semester" at other Universities, enroll for the second semester in the same course or an akin course at the University of Teramo, must produce documentation proving their economic and family requirements within the same deadline that will be established for the submission of scholarship applications.

Article 6

MERIT REQUIREMENTS - CAREER CONTINUITY - FIRST ENROLLMENT

Students will be included in the ranking relating to their year of course, calculated from the year of first enrollment in the level of study attended, also in the case of enrollment in so-called "part-time courses" and regardless of any transfers.

First enrollment means the first enrollment in any University or equivalent Music Institute, wherever and whenever it occurred, including abroad. The year of first enrollment is

identified as follows: the year of first university enrollment after obtaining the high school diploma at any Italian or foreign University or equivalent Music Institute, for those enrolling in a 1st-level three-year degree course or a single-cycle five-year degree course; the year of first enrollment after obtaining the first-level bachelor's degree for those enrolling in a 2nd-level two-year master's degree course at any Italian or foreign University or equivalent Music Institute; the year of first enrollment in a PhD research program or a specialization school after obtaining the master's degree from a single-cycle five-year or 2nd-level two-year course, for those enrolling, respectively, in a PhD program or a specialization school.

PREVIOUS WITHDRAWAL FROM STUDIES

For students who, after withdrawing from studies, have enrolled again, the years prior to the last enrollment are not counted, provided that the University of Teramo or the "G. Braga" Institute has not recognized credits/exams obtained/passed during the previous career. In this case, they can participate in the competition if they meet the further condition of having returned all amounts possibly received during the period of withdrawal or referred to the cost of services possibly used. The student must prove, through suitable documentation, the return of anything possibly received from another body for the Right to University Education or from any other public or private body that financed their previous studies. In case of withdrawal from studies in previous academic years, the position in the provisional ranking referred to in Art. 13 will be suspended; in this case, the student must provide via ticket, to be sent from their personal profile no later than the strict deadline of 10 days, UNDER PENALTY OF EXCLUSION, from the publication of the approval of the provisional ranking in the DSU Agency Board, a self-declaration issued pursuant to Presidential Decree no. 445 of 28.12.2000 and subsequent amendments and integrations, in which they certify: that they do not have recognized credits for exams taken in their previous career; that they did not receive scholarships in their previous career; or that they returned the scholarships received in their previous career, attaching documentation proving the payment. Certifications issued in previous academic years are not considered, as it is mandatory to repeat the presentation of the aforementioned self-declaration at the time of submitting the new scholarship application. In case of untruthful declarations, formation or use of false documents, the criminal sanctions provided for by Art. 76 of the same Presidential Decree apply, and subsequent actions will be taken in accordance with current legislation. Subsequent audits by the Agency are reserved.

SPECIAL CASES

The following are not considered periods of study interruption and must not be included in the calculation of the years of course: interruption of studies for at least two academic years, for which the student requests the reintegration of their career; performance of civil military service; for female students, the birth year of each child; severe and prolonged illness, duly certified; career prior to forfeiture, provided that the University has not confirmed credits/exams obtained/passed in that period.

Article 7

MERIT REQUIREMENTS: CASES OF TRANSITION FROM 1ST LEVEL TO 2ND LEVEL CAREER

Students attending a 1st-level three-year degree course who compete as enrolled in the first year beyond the regular duration (*fuori corso*), if they graduate in the a.y. 2025/26, can participate, giving immediate communication, as enrolled in the first year of a 2nd-level two-year master's course, provided that they have obtained by the deadline of this call (September 7, 2026 – Art. 3) the minimum merit of 150 credits, without using any bonus. Students who compete as enrolled in the first year of a 2nd-level two-year master's degree course, as they are certain to graduate from their 1st-level three-year degree course in the a.y. 2025/2026, must have acquired by the deadline of this call (September 7, 2026, Art. 3) the minimum merit of 150 credits, without using any bonus.

Article 8

MERIT REQUIREMENTS: CREDITS AND GRADES

With the exception of those enrolled in the first year, merit is calculated by multiplying the sum of the credits (including educational credits) by the sum of the grades obtained in the exams scheduled in the study plan, taken starting from the first year of the course and by August 10, 2026. Likewise, for participants in International Mobility Programs, only exams taken by August 10, 2026, are considered.

STUDENTS ENROLLED IN SPECIALIZATION SCHOOLS OR PHD PROGRAMMES

STUDENTS MUST MEET THE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE RELEVANT ACADEMIC REGULATIONS. THESE REQUIREMENTS MUST ALSO CONTINUE TO BE MET IN SUBSEQUENT YEARS, WHERE APPLICABLE, IN ORDER TO RETAIN THE SCHOLARSHIP.

STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE OLD ACADEMIC SYSTEM – "G. BRAGA" INSTITUTE

FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE ADVANCED LEVEL OF THE OLD ACADEMIC SYSTEM WHO HOLD A SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA, IN ADDITION TO BEING DULY ENROLLED AT THE "G. BRAGA" INSTITUTE WITHIN THE PRESCRIBED DEADLINES, THE ACADEMIC MERIT REQUIREMENT CONSISTS OF PASSING THE COMPULSORY PROGRESSION EXAMINATION BY 30 NOVEMBER 2026 WITH A MINIMUM GRADE OF 9.50/10.

Article 9

BONUS(ONLY FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN YEARS FOLLOWING THE FIRST)

The **bonus** consists of a number of **additional CFU** that may be used to meet the **minimum academic merit requirement** for access to the benefits available in the academic year in which the student intends to enrol. It may be **used only once throughout the student's entire university career**.

If the full bonus is **not required** to reach the minimum number of credits, it will be **automatically used only to the extent necessary**, and the **remaining balance may be carried forward and used in subsequent years**.

For the purpose of determining a student's position in the **ranking lists**, the credits corresponding to the **bonus allocation are assigned a value of zero**.

The amount of **bonus credits available** depends on the student's **year of study**, as follows:

Article 10

DEFINITION OF STUDENT STATUS

The status of students is defined based on their place of origin, considering the distances resulting from "Google Maps" by choosing the shortest route between the residence and the university site attended, according to the following typologies:

LOCAL STUDENT (IN SEDE): students with registered residence in a place located at a maximum distance of 20 km from the site of the course of study attended, as well as students who, residing in locations more than 50 km away from the course site, do not take rented accommodation for payment and spend a round-trip travel time via public transport of over 4 total daily hours.

COMMUTER STUDENT (PENDOLARE): students with registered residence in a place located at a distance between 21 km and 49 km from the site of the course of study attended, as well as students who, residing in locations more than 50 km away from the course site, do not take rented accommodation for payment and spend a round-trip travel time via public transport of less than 4 total daily hours.

NON-LOCAL STUDENT (FUORI SEDE): students with registered residence in a place located at a minimum distance of 50 km from the site of the course of study attended and who, exclusively for study purposes, enter into a lease contract as specified below. A non-local student who takes accommodation on the basis of a non-onerous (free) contract will be considered a commuter and is required to submit the document as specified below.

International students whose family household DOES NOT reside in Italy are considered "non-local" on the condition that they submit, within the strict terms of the subsequent Art. 11, a registered lease contract for payment, entered into in their own name in Italy for university attendance; otherwise, they will be considered "local" students.

The lease contracts must concern properties located within 20 km from the course site; otherwise, the student is not considered "non-local".

NON-LOCAL STUDENTS WITH ACCOMMODATION OPTION

Students, when submitting the online scholarship application as non-local, having registered residence in a place located at a minimum distance of 50 km from the site of the course of study attended, can opt, as an alternative to entering into a lease contract, to stay at the "STUDI HUB" residence located in Teramo, Via Balzarini. THE OPTION MUST BE INDICATED ON THE SPECIFIC PAGE OF THE ONLINE APPLICATION FOR OBTAINING THE SCHOLARSHIP The regulations of the specific competition Call approved and

published by ADSU Teramo on the website www.adsuteramo.it for the assignment of accommodation at the "STUDI HUB" Residence for a.y. 2026/27, named: "CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF BED SPACES AT THE 'STUDI HUB' HOUSING RESIDENCE SITUATED IN TERAMO VIA BALZARINI A.Y. 2026/2027", also apply to these students.

Article 11

LEASE CONTRACT

The contract, entered for consideration for study purposes in the city hosting the degree course and regularly registered with the Revenue Agency, must have a minimum duration of 10 months in the period from October 1, 2026, to September 30, 2027, excluding the month of August. In case of early withdrawal from the lease contract, without prejudice to the office checks carried out by the Agency, the student is obliged to give immediate communication via ticket from their personal profile to allow the recalculation of the scholarship amounts, to be settled upon payment of the second installment. In case of participation in international mobility programs, the student will submit, within the same deadline and in addition to the contract in Italy, a self-declaration via ticket from their personal profile regarding the duration of the stay abroad, to be integrated subsequently with the submission, always via ticket, of the lease contract entered into in the host country. All interested students, even if initially excluded and subsequently readmitted to the ranking following the submission of a review request, are required to upload the relative documentation in digital format through the specific section of their personal profile no later than the strict deadline of November 20, 2026, pending the outcome of the review request. Non-local students enrolling in the so-called "filter semester" pursuant to D.M. MUR no. 447 of 11/07/2025 at the University of Teramo and non-local students who, after completing the so-called "filter semester" at other Universities, enroll for the second semester in the same course or an akin course at the University of Teramo, must produce one or more registered lease contracts for consideration for study purposes in the city hosting the degree course, regularly registered with the Revenue Agency, with a minimum duration of 3 months in the period from October 1, 2026, to September 30, 2027, excluding the month of August, no later than the strict deadline that will be indicated in the specific NOTICE OF REOPENING OF TERMS to be approved and published by ADSU Teramo.

N.B. Failure to comply with the method and deadline for uploading the contract and the certification of its registration onto the platform will result in a change of status. Beneficiary students considered "non-local" by virtue of the lease contract are awarded the accommodation portion of the scholarship in cash, in addition to the cash portion.

Article 12

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNTS

Scholarships consist of a cash portion, which includes an accommodation portion due only to non-local students, and a food portion, which is never cashable.

The accommodation portion of a maximum amount of €1,747.39 is due in the case of a non-local student who signs a lease contract pursuant to Arts. 10 and 11 of this competition call.

The amount of the accommodation portion, up to a maximum value of €1,747.39, cannot exceed the total expenditure resulting from the lease contract, understood as the sum of 10 monthly rental payments to be paid in the period from October 2026 to September 2027, excluding August.

For those who use the accommodation service with costs borne by other public bodies, the accommodation portion, up to a maximum of €1,747.39, will correspond to what was actually paid by the students.

The accommodation portion is withheld from students who, when presenting the online scholarship application as non-local, selected the option to stay at the "STUDI HUB" residence in Teramo, Via Balzarini, and were assigned bed spaces as winners of the relative call following the publication of the ranking.

The regulations of the specific competition Call approved and published by the ADSU Teramo for the assignment of accommodation at the "STUDI HUB" residence for a.y. 2026/27, named: *CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE ALLOCATION PLACES AT THE "STUDI HUB" HOUSING RESIDENCE LOCATED IN TERAMO (VIA BALZARINI) ACADEMIC YEAR 2026/2027 FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF TERAMO AND THE "G. BRAGA" INSTITUTE*, also apply to these students.

The food portion is in no case cashable, even in the event of suspension of the catering service for any reason, as the fixed costs of the service must be guaranteed even during

canteen closures. The weekly opening hours and days consider the actual requests for the service by the students, which must be such as to guarantee the economic sustainability of the service.

For students enrolled in the first year beyond the regular duration (fuori corso), the scholarship will be granted for one semester and will be equal to half of its value.

The scholarship amounts, pursuant to MUR Decree no. 175 of 10/02/2026 and subsequent regional guidelines established with Regional Council Resolution no. 397 of 29/06/2026, will be determined in relation to the status and belonging to one of the three brackets determined by one's own I.S.E.E. valid for university benefits, as reported below:

N.B. To the cash portion of non-local students, the monetization of the accommodation portion is added, which is equal to €1,747.39 and is due to the non-local beneficiary who presents the lease contract.

For non-local students enrolling in the so-called "filter semester" pursuant to D.M. MUR no. 447 of 11/07/2025 at the University of Teramo and non-local students who, after completing the so-called "filter semester" at other Universities, enroll for the second semester in the same course or an akin course at the University of Teramo, the accommodation portion is calculated according to the criteria established in Art. 11.

NON-CUMULATIVE INCREASES OF THE CASH PORTIONS OF SCHOLARSHIPS

Pursuant to MIUR Decree no. 1320 of 17/12/2021, the following non-cumulative increases of the cash portions of scholarships are scheduled:

- **15% INCREASE** in favor of beneficiaries presenting an ISEE value less than or equal to €12,167.56.
- **20% INCREASE** in favor of female students enrolled in S.T.E.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) courses of study.

The increases do not apply to the food portion or the accommodation portion, even if the latter is monetized.

INCREASE OF THE CASH PORTIONS FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT

Pursuant to MIUR Decree no. 1320 of 17/12/2021, a 20% increase is scheduled in the case of students enrolled simultaneously in two courses of study.

These students are allowed to obtain and maintain the scholarship, increased by 20%, where they possess and maintain the requirements scheduled for the entire duration of the courses. The increase is not due in the event that the student loses the requirements for the scholarship with reference to the course of study to which the student has correlated the aforementioned increase. To benefit from the integration, the student must have made and completed enrollment in more than one degree course for all academic years for which they obtained the scholarship.

The student must indicate in the online application the enrollment in the main course, i.e., the one in which they are attending the highest year of career, and in the external online application to be accessed always from the personal profile, the data of the second course in which they are enrolled.

THE SUPPLEMENTARY APPLICATION FOR DUAL ENROLLMENT MUST BE SUBMITTED BY THE STRICT DEADLINE OF 12:00 PM ON SEPTEMBER 7, 2026.

In the event that the student is a scholarship beneficiary and also meets the merit requirements for the second course, they obtain a 20% increase on the scholarship amount. In the event they do not meet the merit requirements for the second course, they remain a beneficiary but do not obtain the 20% increase.

The increase does not apply to the food portion or the accommodation portion, even if the latter is monetized.

Article 13

FORMATION OF RANKINGS AND REVIEW REQUEST

The publication of the act approving the rankings in the Online Official Notice Board (Albo Pretorio Online) on the website www.adsuteramo.it is considered by law as notification of the outcome of the applications to the participants of the Competition.

The first provisional ranking, approved tentatively by October 2026, will list eligible students (potential scholarship beneficiaries) and non-eligible students.

International students who have not transmitted income and asset documents by September 7, 2026, will be considered suspended.

Students enrolling in the so-called "filter semester" pursuant to D.M. MUR no. 447 of 11/07/2025 at the University of Teramo will be suspended in the ranking until final enrollment, which must in any case occur within the terms of this call.

No later than 10 days from the publication of the act approving the first provisional ranking in the Board of the Company, students who are non-eligible can submit a review request filled out exclusively online from their personal profile, under penalty of definitive exclusion from the competition.

No later than 10 days from the publication of the act approving the first provisional ranking in the Board of the Company, students suspended for previous withdrawal can send the self-declaration referred to in Art. 6 of this Call to the Company via ticket from their personal profile, under penalty of definitive exclusion from the competition.

The outcome of the review request will be made known exclusively with the publication of the act approving the updated ranking in the Online Official Notice Board of the Company by December.

For students who, after completing the so-called "filter semester" at other Universities, enroll for the second semester in the same course or an akin course at the University of Teramo and submit the scholarship application within the terms to be announced later, the first provisional ranking will be published within thirty days of the deadline for submitting applications. No later than 10 days from the publication of the provisional ranking, students who are non-eligible can submit a review request filled out exclusively online from their personal profile, under penalty of definitive exclusion from the competition.

The outcome of the review request will be made known exclusively with the publication of the act approving the updated ranking in the Online Official Notice Board of the Company.

The Company in any case reserves the right to intervene by office on the rankings, making all corrections deemed necessary and appropriate in self-protection (autotutela).

Article 14

TIMES AND METHODS OF PAYMENT OF THE SCHOLARSHIP - SUSPENSION MANAGEMENT

Payments are made exclusively via bank transfer.

The deadlines set by this call for payments do not take into account the technical times necessary for credit clearing.

Students must indicate in their online profile the IBAN relating to a bank or postal current account, held in their own name or joint-named, opened in Italy, or relating to an electronic payment card. The account or card must be suitable financial instruments to receive bank transfers from private banking institutions.

The Company is not responsible for payment delays due to the indication of an incorrect IBAN or referred to accounts or cards held in a name other than the student's.

ADVANCE ON THE FIRST INSTALLMENT FOR ENROLLED FIRST-YEAR STUDENTS OF 1ST LEVEL OR SINGLE-CYCLE COURSES

For students enrolled in the first year of degree courses or first-level diplomas (three-year courses) and single-cycle master's degree courses (five-year courses), an advance on the first installment, equal to 20% of the scholarship's cash portion, is paid by November 10, 2026.

Any monetized accommodation portion is excluded from this share, as the deadline for presenting lease contracts (set by Art. 11 of this call for applications) is after November 20, which is necessary for the recognition of "non-local" status and the consequent right to such higher amount.

To obtain the advance, it is essential that students have finalized enrollment by the deadline of October 7, 2026, regardless of the date set by university regulations.

International students must also have produced the income and asset documents scheduled in Art. 5 of this call by 07/09/2026 to obtain the advance.

FIRST INSTALLMENT

By December 31, 2026, the first installment of the scholarship is paid to the beneficiary students. The first installment is equal to 50% of the scholarship's cash portion, i.e., excluding the food portion which is never cashable, minus any advance paid by November

10, 2026. Payments are suspended for first-year students if they are not enrolled, including students attending the so-called "filter semester" at the University of Teramo.

For students who, after completing the so-called "filter semester" at other Universities, enroll for the second semester in the same course or an akin course at the University of Teramo and are beneficiaries of a scholarship following the updated ranking, pursuant to Art. 13 of this competition call, the first installment is paid on a monthly basis, once enrollment is verified.

SECOND INSTALLMENT FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN YEARS FOLLOWING THE FIRST

By June 30, 2027, the second installment as a balance of the scholarship will be paid to students enrolled in years following the first.

SECOND INSTALLMENT FOR FIRST-YEAR ENROLLED STUDENTS

For students enrolled in the first year of degree courses, the second installment of the scholarship will be paid upon reaching a minimum merit level equal to 20 credits, provided they are acquired by August 10, 2027, following verification by the Company.

A student who has not acquired the above-indicated number of credits by that date will no longer have a right to the second installment of the scholarship.

The second installment will normally be paid in June, July, and September 2027, once the information is acquired by office from the competent Student Secretariats, without the need for communications by those concerned.

SECOND INSTALLMENT FOR ENROLLED STUDENTS OF SPECIALIZATION SCHOOLS AND PHD RESEARCH

For students enrolled in specialization schools and PhD programs, the second installment of the scholarship will be paid following verification by the Company of passing the exam for admission to the next year, where scheduled. Failure to pass the exam results in forfeiture of the right to the second installment of the scholarship. In other cases, the second installment is paid by June 2027.

SUSPENSION MANAGEMENT

Once the payments of the first installment and any advance have been made by 2026, the Company will pay on a bimonthly basis starting from the subsequent month of February:

- Students suspended for not having entered their IBAN in their online profile, provided they have done so in the meantime;
- Students suspended due to a mismatch between declared credits and credits resulting in the secretariat, provided they have had any missing exams registered and there is therefore correspondence with what was declared in the application, and that they communicate the correct data via ticket in any case.

Article 15

REGIONAL TAX AND UNIVERSITY FEES

Students who are eligible in the rankings are exempted from the regional tax for the Right to University Education and from university fees.

Students who were eligible or beneficiaries for the previous a.y. 2025-2026 are not required to pay fees for a.y. 2026-2027 until the publication of the updated ranking, which will take place by December 2026. Once the ranking is published, students who are not eligible must pay fees within the terms established by the University.

First-year enrolled students who have paid only the first installment of fees upon enrollment and are subsequently eligible in the December 2026 ranking will receive a refund after the approval of the definitive rankings, tentatively in March/April 2027.

Article 16

ACTIONS IN FAVOR OF STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES

For students possessing a disability percentage equal to or higher than 66%, resulting from certification issued by a specific ASL medical commission, pursuant to Law no. 68/1999 as amended, or with a recognized disability pursuant to Law no. 104/1992 as amended, the number of household members is increased by two units, and an integration of the scholarship equal to 40% of the cash portion is recognized.

The integration is incompatible with the increases scheduled in Art. 12 of this call.

The increase does not apply to the food portion or the accommodation portion, even if the latter is monetized.

The documentation certifying the disability or invalidity mentioned above must be transmitted electronically through one's online profile by the non-strict deadline of September 7, 2026.

Students with disabilities who are first-year scholarship beneficiaries are excluded from the provisions relating to merit verification for the 2nd installment of the scholarship (Art. 14) and any revocation, and therefore the cash portion is paid in a single installment.

Article 17

EXCLUSIONS AND INCOMPATIBILITIES

Students are excluded from the rankings if they:

- Do not possess, also following subsequent office verifications, the requirements requested by this call or do not respect its deadlines, which are all strict (peremptory), unless expressly indicated otherwise;
- Incur disciplinary sanctions higher than a warning;
- Enroll, after submitting the application, in a degree course or a course year other than the one indicated in the application itself. This provision is not valid for first-year students who fall into a single ranking;
- Withdraw from studies or the benefit. In this case, they are required to communicate it promptly to the Company;
- Transfer to other Universities during the a.y. 2026/27;
- Already hold a qualification of equal level to the course attended.

The scholarship cannot be combined with other scholarships or benefits, however named, granted for any reason for the a.y. 2026/2027, even if after the date of submission of the application to participate in this competition.

In this case, the student must choose one benefit or the other.

An exception is made for scholarships granted by the University for carrying out part-time collaboration activities referred to in Art. 11 of Legislative Decree 68/2012.

Article 18

RETURN OF SUMS RECEIVED FOLLOWING LOSS OF THE BENEFIT

In case of loss of benefit, the sums received and the value of the services enjoyed must be returned to the Company.

The value of the food portion to be returned will be calculated by multiplying the number of meals consumed by the cost of the first bracket canteen service (€2.00).

Beneficiaries of scholarships enrolled in years following the first who, during the academic year, leave their studies or transfer, will enjoy the benefit assigned to them in twelfths (pro-rata); this rule is not applicable to first-year enrolled students.

Any services to be returned will be counted up to the actual date of communication of withdrawal from studies.

In order to facilitate the return of revoked scholarships, the Company notes the possibility of resorting to the Fund for Credit to Youth (so-called Fondo Studio), scheduled by the Interministerial Decree of 17/11/2025, published in G.U. no. 19 of 24/1/2026.

For this purpose, interested students can obtain more information at the address <https://www.consap.it/fondostudio/>.

Article 19

BENEFITS RELATED TO INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY

Eligible students in the ranking have the right, only once in their entire university career, to an integration of the scholarship for participation in International Mobility Programs that have academic recognition in terms of credits within their course of study in Italy.

The monthly contribution of €600.00 is calculated on the duration of the stay abroad, up to a maximum of ten months.

Any European and/or state contributions obtained are deducted from the maximum amount of the monthly contribution recognized by ADSU.

To the monthly contribution, a flat-rate reimbursement of travel expenses is added, equal to €100.00 for European countries and €500.00 for non-European countries.

The contribution is paid after returning to Italy, once the results of the experience and the number of months of stay are verified, as certified by the competent university offices.

Article 20

INTEGRATION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP FOR GRADUATING ON TIME

A beneficiary student who obtains their degree within the duration scheduled by their respective teaching regulations receives an integration of the scholarship equal to half of the amount obtained in the last year of the course.

The 50% integration does not apply to the food portion or the accommodation portion, even if the latter is monetized.

The Company provides by office to pay the due integration, normally acquiring the list of graduates as of July 31, 2027, December 31, 2027, and April 30, 2028.

Article 21

STUDENT DINING SERVICE

The application to participate in this Competition is also valid for the catering service.

Scholarship beneficiaries and students enrolled in years following the first who are eligible in the ranking have the right to a free meal.

First-year enrolled students who are eligible for the scholarship based on the updated ranking published by December 2026 pay the reduced price of €2.00 for each meal and can benefit from free food only starting from the publication date of the ranking in which they become beneficiaries.

Students enrolling in the so-called "filter semester" pursuant to D.M. MUR no. 447 of 11/07/2025 at the University of Teramo use the canteen service on the condition that the semester consists of at least 51% in-person teaching activities.

Article 22

CHECKS AND SANCTIONS

The Company, pursuant to current legislation, will carry out verifications on all applications received.

In the event that the investigations show that untruthful declarations have been presented, the Company will proceed to recover the sum or value of the benefits and/or services already paid, as scheduled by current legislation, and to report to the Judicial Authority for any verification of crimes referred to in Arts. 438, 495, 640 of the Criminal Code.

In addition to returning the paid sum, the student, pursuant to Legislative Decree 68/2012, Art. 10, paragraph 3, will be subject to a sanction equal to three times the amount received

and will lose the right to obtain other disbursements for the duration of the course of study, without prejudice in any case to the application of the sanctions scheduled by criminal laws for acts constituting a crime.

Article 23

TREATMENT OF PERSONAL DATA
